

FIND BOOKS TO CHECK OUT AND FOLLOW THESE RULES.

1. BOOKS THAT ARE REPORTED ON NEED TO BE CHECKED OUT AT FONDULAC DISTRICT LIBRARY. BOOKS FROM HOME OR CHECKED OUT AT ANOTHER LIBRARY WILL NOT COUNT.
2. BOOKS NEED TO BE AT PARTICIPANTS READING LEVEL.
3. CARTOON BOOKS, MAY BE COUNTED. THERE IS A LIMIT OF THREE CARTOON BOOKS.
4. DRAWING BOOKS, CHILDREN'S MAGAZINES, BOOKS ON CD CANNOT BE COUNTED.
5. BOOK ON CD WITH BOOK CAN BE COUNTED.
6. A PARTICIPANT MAY READ TO A YOUNGER SIBLING WHO IS IN THE "READ TO ME" PROGRAM. THE PARTICIPANT CAN RECEIVE ONE BOOK CREDIT FOR EVERY 10 BOOKS THAT IS READ TO A SIBLING. THREE BOOK CREDITS MAY BE EARNED THIS WAY.
7. WHEN READING FROM A CHAPTER BOOK AND THE BOOK HAS:
 - 1-100 PAGES, IT COUNTS AS 1 BOOK
 - 101-200 PAGES, IT COUNTS AS 2 BOOKS
 - 201-300 PAGES, IT COUNTS AS 3 BOOKS
 - OVER 300 PAGES, IT COUNTS AS 4 BOOKS
8. BOOKS NEED TO BE CHECKED OUT FOR 24 HOURS BEFORE THEY CAN BE REPORTED ON.
9. BOOKS ARE TO BE RETURNED UPSTAIRS, THEY DO NOT NEED TO BE BROUGHT TO THE CHILDREN'S DEPARTMENT TO BE REPORTED.
10. ONLY BOOKS CHECKED OUT AFTER JUNE 1 WILL QUALIFY.
11. PARTICIPANTS WILL RECEIVE ONLY ONE PRIZE PER WEEK (MONDAY-SATURDAY).

PRESCHOOL-1ST GRADE — READ TO ME

1. PARTICIPANTS WILL RECEIVE A PRIZE AT 15 BOOKS, 30 BOOKS, AND 45 BOOKS.
2. PARTICIPANTS MAY REPORT UP TO 15 BOOKS PER WEEK. (MONDAY-SATURDAY)

2ND & 3RD GRADE

1. CHAPTER BOOKS OR PICTURE BOOKS MAY BE USED. IF THE PARTICIPANT IS IN THIRD GRADE AND CHOOSES TO READ A BOOK FROM THE PICTURE BOOK SECTION, THE BOOKS NEED TO HAVE MORE WORDS ON THE PAGES. IF UNSURE ABOUT A BOOK, ASK SOMEONE AT THE CHILDREN'S DESK.
2. PARTICIPANTS WILL RECEIVE A PRIZE AT 10 BOOKS, 20 BOOKS, AND 30 BOOKS.
3. PARTICIPANTS MAY REPORT UP TO 10 BOOKS PER WEEK. (MONDAY-SATURDAY)

4TH & 5TH GRADE

1. PARTICIPANTS NEED TO SELECT BOOKS FROM THE J FICTION OR NON-FICTION SECTION. FICTION BOOKS NEED TO HAVE 70 PAGES OR MORE TO COUNT. NON-FICTION BOOKS HAVE TO BE AT READING LEVEL. IF THERE ARE SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES, PLEASE LET US KNOW.
2. PARTICIPANTS WILL RECEIVE A PRIZE AT 5 BOOKS, 10 BOOKS, AND 15 BOOKS.
3. PARTICIPANTS MAY REPORT UP TO 5 BOOKS PER WEEK. (MONDAY-SATURDAY)
