

Getting FREE Library eBooks and Audiobooks for iOS devices (iPhone/iPad/iPod touch)

You can use the OverDrive app to get eBooks and audiobooks from the library on your iOS device (iPhone/iPad/iPod touch).



Required

- ✓ Valid library card and PIN/password
- ✓ Apple ID
- ✓ Wifi connection
- ✓ iPhone/iPad/iPod touch
- ✓ Device charger

Step 1

Download the **OverDrive** app from the **Apple App Store**.

Step 2

Open the OverDrive app and follow the prompts to create an OverDrive account and sign in.

If you're under 13, you may have multiple sign-in options.

Step 3

In the OverDrive app, swipe from left to right to open the **Home menu**. Then, tap **Add a library** to find your library's OverDrive website.

- Tap the star to save your library to your library list.
- Tap your library's name to start browsing.

Step 4

Log into your library's OverDrive website with your library card and borrow a title. Call 699-3917 if you don't know your library card number or PIN.

Step 5


Find borrowed titles on your **Bookshelf** (under your **Account**) on your library's OverDrive website. From here, you can:

- **Download/Add** EPUB eBooks and MP3 audiobooks directly to the OverDrive app.
- **Add** streaming videos to the OverDrive app.
- Tap **Read** to open and read OverDrive Read or MediaDo Reader eBooks right in your browser.
- Tap **Listen** to open and play OverDrive Listen audiobooks right in your browser.
- If you've installed the Kindle reading app from the Apple App Store, select **Download**, then **Kindle Book** (U.S. only) to complete checkout on Amazon's website and send the book to your Kindle reading app.

Return Books Early

How to return eBooks, audiobooks, or streaming videos

1. From your app bookshelf, tap and hold a title to display its return options.

***Note:** If you're using the legacy version of OverDrive's app, tap the  icon to display the return/delete options.*



2. You can **Return** a title to the library, which also deletes it from your device.
You can **Delete** a title from your device, but you will still have it checked out to your library account.
